MEG McCRUMMEN FOWLER, Ph.D., *Director and Lead Curator of Clotilda: The Exhibition*

Dr. Fowler has served as director of the History Museum of Mobile for four years. She holds a Ph.D. in Art History & Society from Tulane University, where she also completed an M.A. in the history of art. Her undergraduate degree is from The University of Alabama in history and French. Before joining the History Museum of Mobile, Meg served as a visiting scholar in the Center for the Study of War and Memory at the University of South Alabama (USA) and taught in the Art & Art History department. In 2018, she completed a curatorial fellowship at the Musée d'Orsay in Paris. In her current role, she operates four museum sites: the History Museum of Mobile, Africatown Heritage House, Colonial Fort Conde, and the Phoenix Fire Museum.
